LAKE CHARACTERISTICS
No thermal stratification was evident at the time of the survey (July 17 to August 17, 1972). Water temperatures ranged from 66.5°F at the surface to 46.1°F at 97 feet. The dissolved oxygen content varied from 8.6 parts per million at the surface to 4.0 at 56 feet. An average pH of 6.1 indicated an acidic characteristic in relation to the hydrogen ion composition in the water. A total dissolved solids concentration of 22 parts per million was determined from a conductivity reading near the surface. Light penetration in this greenish water was indicated by the disappearance of the secchi disc from view, 12.1 feet below the surface.

FISH SPECIES PRESENT
Yellow pickerel, northern pike, smallmouth bass, lake whitefish, rock bass, white sucker, yellow perch, lake herring, burbot, golden shiner, Iowa darter, and mottled sculpin.

FISHING
Lady Evelyn Lake is known for its excellent yellow pickerel fishing. They may be taken in the evening in the shallows and off shoals near shore using a variety of artificial lures such as flatfish, Rapalas, jigs and live bait.

ACCESS AND FACILITIES
Lady Evelyn Lake is located approximately 25 miles north-west of Temagami. Road access is available to Mowat Landing, located 12 miles west of Highway #11 on Highway #558. Access from here necessitates a portage from the Montreal River over the Mattawapika Power Dam to the Lady Evelyn River, which leads upstream to the northeast arm of Lady Evelyn Lake. The shoreline offers excellent camping sites. Accommodation and other fishery related services are available in the immediate area.
